

LASER OPTICS SOCIETY SAFETY AGREEMENT

Students working in the Laser Optics Lab (LOL) as part of the Laser Optics Society (LOS) agree to the following:

1. Before you are permitted to work in the LOL you will view each of the safety videos listed in the Laser Safety Program. These include:
 - a. Mastering Light
(20 minute DVD available at the LOL)
 - b. Harvard Laser Safety Videos 1, 2, and 3
(Approx 15 minutes each, on-line at <http://www.safety.seas.harvard.edu/movies/list.html>)
2. Your behavior in the lab at all times will be appropriate for a crowded room with expensive, dangerous, and sensitive equipment.
3. In the lab you will at all times handle equipment with regard to safe use and respect for the safety of others.
4. You will not intentionally look directly at a laser beam or its reflection, nor will you intentionally point a laser or its reflection at another individual.
5. You will not turn on the power to any laser without proper authority to do so from the Director of the LOL.
6. You will not disassemble or open up the housing of any of the LOL lasers.
7. You will read and abide by the Safety Rules and Beam Alignment Procedures described in the Laser Safety Program.
8. You will help keep the lab clean, and will refrain from bringing food, drink or other extraneous materials into the lab.

I have viewed all four of the videos listed above, and I agree to act safely in the Laser Optics Lab by complying with all of the requirements listed above.
